We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This Site collects some personal data from its users.

This Privacy Policy informs you of our views, practices, and policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data we receive from users of the Site.

By submitting personal data to us, you agree to us using your personal data as follows.

INFORMATION COLLECTION, PURPOSE, AND USE

While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to name, email address, cookies, usage data, and password.

We may use your personal information to

- manage contacts and send messages
- ensure that content from our site is presented most effectively for you and for your computer
- provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us, which may be of interest to you
- interact with external social networks and platforms

- monitor infrastructure

Log Data

In addition, we may use third-party services, such as Google Analytics, to collect, monitor, and analyze this data.

DATA STORAGE

Your personal data may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA").

By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storage, or processing. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

LAWFUL BASIS OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

We may process personal data relating to users if one of the following applies:

- users have given their consent for one or more specific purposes;
- provision of data is necessary for the performance of an agreement with the user and/or for any pre-contractual obligations thereof;
- processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject;
- processing is required for the purposes of our legitimate interests or those of a third party.

DATA RETENTION

We process and store your personal data for as long as required by the purpose for which they were collected..

Therefore:

- Personal data collected for the performance of a contract between us and the user will be retained until the contract has been fully performed.

- Personal data collected for our legitimate interests will be retained for as long as necessary to fulfill those purposes.
- We may retain personal data for a longer period if the user has given consent to such processing, provided that consent is not withdrawn.
- We may be obliged to retain personal data for a longer period whenever required to do so for the performance of a legal obligation or upon order of an authority.

Once the retention period expires, personal data will be deleted, and some of your rights (i.e., the right to access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification, and the right to data portability) will no longer be enforceable.

THIRD-PARTY DISCLOSURE

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer your personal information to outside parties unless we provide users with advance notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release information when its release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property, or safety.

However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be shared with other parties for marketing, advertising, or other purposes.

YOUR RIGHTS

Users have the right to do the following:

- Withdraw their consent at any time. Users have the right to withdraw consent previously given to the processing of their personal data.
- Object to the processing of their data. Users have the right to object to the processing of their data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent.
- Access their data. Users have the right to learn whether we are processing their data, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing, and obtain a copy of the data undergoing processing.
- Verify and seek rectification. Users have the right to verify the accuracy of their data and to request that it be updated or corrected.
- Restrict the processing of their data. Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to restrict the processing of their data. In this case, we will not process their data for any purpose other than storing it.
- Have their personal data deleted or otherwise removed. Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to have their data erased by us.
- Receive their data and have it transferred to another controller. Users have the right to receive their data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format

and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without any undue delay.

- Lodge a complaint. Users have the right to bring a claim before their competent data protection supervisory authority.
